

SCHOOL PROFILE DATA

Results from 2010 – 2011 show that:

KS1

- Boys' reading in KS1 has improved.
- Writing in KS1 has improved for all children.
- There is a large increase in the number of girls in KS1 getting level 3 for reading. 30% achieved Level 3.

KS2

- There is a significant improvement for 2011 in the percentage of children achieving level 4 or above in English, Mathematics and Science from the 2009 test results
- The percentage of children achieving level 4 or above in English, Mathematics and Science was well above the floor target set by the local authority
- In English and Mathematics nine out of every ten children made two or more levels of progress from KS1 to KS2. This represents GOOD progress according to the Ofsted criteria
